



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

This application must be submitted from the school computer program. Students may access the scholarship computer program at all North Building, student-use sites - laptops in classrooms, computer labs, North Library, and North Counseling. There are to be no attachments to the application except where indicated (*). The (*) indicates that you must submit this additional information to the North Counseling Office by April 4th.

The application deadline for most awards is April 4th, but some Part II awards have earlier/later deadlines. (Check your scholarship booklet, Part II.)

Part I awards are determined by the High School Scholarship Committee. Part II awards are determined by local organizations, school department heads, or private individuals. Most Part II awards have their own application form (S) that must be picked up in the counseling center. If any separate applications need a transcript it must be requested from the counseling center at least five (3) working days before the deadline.

FILLING OUT THE COMMON APPLICATION:

1. Type your full name - last name, first name, middle name.
2. Type your Social Security Number.
3. Type your father/guardian's name, occupation and place of employment.
4. Type your mother/guardian's name, occupation and place of employment.
5. Type your post-high school plans including prospective major, if you are undecided, type "undecided." Example: 4 year liberal arts, pre-law
2 year vocational school, carpentry
6. Type your family's gross income for 2011. This is required for any scholarships that ask for "Demonstration of Financial Need."
7. Type the names of schools to which you have applied and indicate all schools to which you have been accepted by typing (A) after them.
8. List all extra curricular activities in which you are involved.
9. List honors and awards you have received in high school.
10. Write your paragraph(s) with information as to why you feel you have the requirements for the scholarships you are applying to.

Check the box before the name of each scholarship/award for which you are applying. Make sure that you meet the requirements for each award.
